New Student Fees

The <u>Admissions Fee</u> is a one-time fee applied to new families for their first year at AAS. This fee is mandatory and non-refundable. The <u>Admissions fee</u> is waived only for new families enrolling at least one child in Kindergarten.

The <u>Registration Fee</u> is an annual, mandatory and non-refundable fee per student. Payment of the Registration Fee guarantees that there will be a place in the class for the student but it does not represent a formal admission until the family has provided the official documents and complied with AAS' admissions requisites.

The <u>Deposit Fee</u> per student is to ensure that all payments have been made. This deposit will be returned, once the student leaves the school and all financial obligations have been met.

<u>Family Discounts</u>: a 2nd child enrolled receives a 20% discount, a 3rd child receives a 40%, a 4th child an 80% and a 5th child and additional children receive a 100% discount. Family discounts do not apply to Corporate payments.

Annual Tuition Fees per student include: all activities during the school day, sports, clubs, childcare service from 8:00 - 8:30 am, college counseling, transcripts, field trips (day trips), and laboratory materials. These fees include the annual Tuition Insurance Policy, which guarantees the continuity of studies for all students enrolled at AAS in the event of the death of one parent or chosen legal guardian.

Fees not included:

- Textbooks/online licenses: Single annual fee of 140 € (G1-G10). The school will indicate which books need to be
 returned at the end of the school year and it is the family's responsibility to ensure that books are returned in good
 condition.
- School uniforms: families can purchase these through our website.
- ESL (English as a Second Language) support: 300 € / month.
- Additional fees for students with documented mild learning disabilities needing learning support may apply.

Annual Lunch Fees

A daily menu will be served to all students from Kindergarten through G8. This service can be contracted by trimesters, and any changes must be communicated at least 1 month in advance. It will be charged in three equal payments in September 2023, January 2024 and April 2024.

Payment Schedule

There are two different methods available for the payment of tuition fees: wire transfer (only for full upfront payment) or direct debit. Upon enrollment, it is mandatory to choose one method, but you may change it in the future by emailing Ms. Alejandra Gentico in our administration department at administracion@aquinasmadrid.es.

A) Full Upfront Payment

A 4% discount will be applied on tuition fees received before July 1st (lunch and transportation fees do not apply).

B) Direct Debit

The cost of the annual fees (tuition and transportation fees) can be divided into 9 monthly payments (K1 – G11) due from September to May and 8 monthly payments for Grade 12 due from September to April only by direct debit. Lunch fees will be charged in 3 equal payments in September, January and April.

In either case, it is mandatory to provide a Spanish bank account in order to debit other fees like lunch, transportation, books, etc. No student will be accepted for enrollment without direct debit.

Please note that parents are liable for all bank charges incurred. All international wire transfers will be received in a net amount.
