New Student Fees

The <u>Admissions Fee</u> is a one-time fee applied to new families for their first year at AAS. This fee is mandatory and non-refundable. The <u>Admissions fee</u> is waived only for new families enrolling at least one child in Kindergarten.

The <u>Registration Fee</u> is an annual, mandatory and non-refundable fee per student. **This fee includes textbooks and online licenses (except for G11 & G12).** Payment of the Registration Fee guarantees that there will be a place in the class for the student but it does not represent a formal admission until the family has provided the official documents and complied with AAS' admissions requirements.

The <u>Deposit Fee</u> is a one-time fee per student to ensure that all payments have been made. This deposit will be returned, once the student leaves the school and all financial obligations have been met.

<u>Family Discounts</u>: 2nd child receives a 10%, 3rd child receives a 30%, 4th child and additional children receive a 75% discount. Family discounts do not apply to corporate payments. Families with a child enrolled in the 2023-24 school year will maintain their current discounts for all their children until they complete their schooling at AAS (both for enrolled children and any siblings not yet enrolled)

Annual Tuition Fees per student include: all activities during the school day, sports, clubs, childcare service from 8:00 - 8:30 am, college counseling, transcripts, field trips (day trips), and laboratory materials. These fees include the annual Tuition Insurance Policy, which guarantees the continuity of studies for all students enrolled at AAS in the event of the death of either parent or chosen legal guardian (for boarding students only partial fees will be covered).

Fees not included

- School uniforms: families can purchase these through our website.
- ESL (English as a Second Language) support: 300 € / month.
- Additional fees for learning support may apply for students with documented mild, learning, disabilities.
- IB Certificates: 600 € per subject made at a one-time payment in G12.
- Fees for recognition, UNED registration, AP exams, etc; The school will manage these processes and will only charge
 the costs incurred by the different third party institutions.

A daily menu will be served to all students from Kindergarten through G8. This service is not mandatory and students may go home for lunch during the period allotted for this purpose. However, food may not be brought from home as the school does not have an assigned space for this purpose. This service can be elected by trimesters, and any changes must be communicated at least 1 month in advance. This service will be charged in September 2024, January and April 2025.

In G9 through G12 the academic courses end at 2:30 p.m. and in the afternoons there are clubs and extracurricular activities. As it is optional for students to stay in the afternoons, it is not required to enroll in the monthly lunch plan. Students can choose between this monthly meal price or simply pay for items a la carte, for which they will have a school card. There is no cafeteria service at the Downtown campus.

AAS Bus Routes do not reach every area of Madrid. Please verify with the front desk the areas covered and request your bus stop by June 30th (<u>frontdesk@aquinasmadrid.es</u>). The bus service will be charged on a monthly basis (from September to June).

Payment Schedule

It is mandatory to provide a Spanish bank account in order to debit all charges (tuition, lunch, transportation, etc). No student will be accepted for enrollment without direct debit.

The fees for K1- G11 will be divided as follows:

- Tuition: 10 monthly payments due from September 2024 to June 2025.
- Lunch: 3 payments due in September 2024, January 2025 and April 2025.
- Transportation: 10 monthly payments from September 2024 to June 2025.

The fees for G12 will be divided as follows:

- Tuition: 8 monthly payments due from September 2024 to April 2025.
- Lunch: 2 payments due in September 2024 and January 2025.
- Transportation: 8 monthly payments from September 2024 to April 2025.

This year, we are offering 2 options of full upfront payment. If you are interested in any of these options please contact Alejandra Gentico in our administration department at administration@aquinasmadrid.es.

- A 7% discount will be applied on annual tuition fees received before March 31st 2024 (does not apply to lunch and transportation fees).
- A 4% discount will be applied on annual tuition fees received before June 30th 2024 (does not apply to lunch and transportation fees).

If a student decides to leave in the middle of the school year, the student will be charged for the entire month during which they leave. To confirm the unenrollment on a certain date, it is required to give at least 10 days' notice by contacting Alejandra Gentico in our administration department at administration@aquinasmadrid.es.

All international wire transfers are received in a net amount. Please note that parents are liable for all bank charges incurred, including those for bounced payments.
